LAS VEGAS – The Nevada Forum will convene approximately 50 demographically matched, lottery-selected Nevada citizens for a groundbreaking, three-day statewide Nevada Forum Civic Assembly. Delegates from across Northern, Southern, and rural Nevada will gather to deliberate on key policy priorities, evaluate cross-partisan solutions, and draft supermajority-backed policy directives aimed at guiding state lawmakers for the upcoming legislative session.

This landmark civic assembly of Nevadans represents the culmination of a months-long, statewide civic effort launched earlier this year. The event builds directly on the momentum of this past summer's Community Conversations, in which hundreds of residents across Nevada voiced their priorities and concerns about the issues that matter most to our state.

By bringing together a diverse group of delegates to transform these community insights into concrete, cross-partisan legislative directives, The Nevada Forum Civic Assembly continues to demonstrate a

powerful model for citizen-led democracy and collaborative governance ahead of the upcoming legislative session.
